#### **SUMMARY:**

The Master TESOL certificate curriculum comprises four introductory graduatelevel courses containing integrated practical field experiences that enable candidates to gain essential knowledge, skills, and dispositions for teaching adult English language-learners in diverse contexts throughout the world. Students analyze various domains of language (grammar, lexicon, phonetics, and pragmatics) in relation to adult learner language development, and apply these understandings to adult English language teaching. Students design, adapt, and evaluate curricula, technology, media, and other resources that meet the specific instructional and language-related needs and abilities of adult English language learners. An understanding of the multilingual/multicultural contexts of English language learners live and work in and usage of English on a global scale is developed.

#### **Entry Qualifications**

1. Bachelor Degree Completion
2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.

#### **School Hours That Meet Your Time Schedule**

In accordance with regulations governing classroom attendance, classes can be planned and scheduled on weekends and National Holidays as not to interfere with student regular working hours.
