This master's degree teaches students advanced concepts relating to naturopathic medicine, patient care and office administration. Graduate education in homeopathy also includes a research thesis conducted under the guidance of a faculty member.

Entry Qualifications

- 1. Bachelor Degree Completion
- 2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.

Further Education application requirements and procedures:

- 1. Completion of application form
- 2. Presentation of documents of previous educational achievement (transcripts)
