### Master Degree Admission Application Course Details

#### **SUMMARY:**

This academic graduate degree consists of study in theology, with a focus on specific areas such as dogmatic, historical, moral, sacramental, or scriptural. It prepares students for leadership in a wide range of vocations by cultivating skills in the study and interpretation of Scripture. It enables students to fashion a systematic theological framework, and develop an understanding of the origin and growth of the Christian tradition in all its richness and diversity. Writing and defense of a thesis is normally required.

#### **Entry Qualifications**

1. Bachelor Degree Completion
2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.

#### **School Hours That Meet Your Time Schedule**

In accordance with regulations governing classroom attendance, classes can be planned and scheduled on weekends and National Holidays as not to interfere with student regular working hours.

#### **Further Education application requirements and procedures:**

1. Completion of application form
2. Presentation of documents of previous educational achievement (transcripts)
3. After completion of formal school registration, student identity card will be issued

## Future Prospects:

Graduates in Theology have many career opportunities. Pastoral positions are the most common but not the only ones. Any business or organization that is in need of a person with leadership abilities to govern it is open to employment of graduates. Civic and social organization positions that serve the public are also in demand. Teaching of the gospel in secondary schools and universities is another option.
