Fine Arts

A Bachelor of Fine Arts program gives you extensive studio time and guidance to create your art and prepare you for a career as an artist, musician, actor or other fine artist. It is a professional degree taken at the undergraduate level. This degree offers students an intensive course of study in subjects considered to be fine arts. These disciplines include painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, creative writing, filmmaking, theater and digital arts. Heavy emphasis on the liberal arts as well as the specific artistic disciplines is studied.

Entry Qualifications

1. Senior High School completion or higher
2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.

School Hours That Meet Your Time Schedule

In accordance with the National Ministry of Education regulations classes can be planned and scheduled on weekends and National Holidays as not to influence student working hours.

Further Education application requirements and procedures:

1. Completion of application form
2. Presentation of documents of previous educational achievement (transcripts)
