Bachelor Degree Admission Application Course Details

Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) in Music program introduces the various aspects of music, both conceptual and practical. Students in this program may take either educational courses or more stringent music performance majors. Depending on the course offerings available to students and the candidate's musical background the program will be specific to each student's needs. Graduates may have skills and knowledge which focus on a range of topics, from music education, theory, music history and performance oriented majors. Graduates in music partake in a variety of careers in the music industry. Music baccalaureate programs require applicants to be competent musicians with a substantial musical skill.

Entry Qualifications

1. Senior High School completion or higher
2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.

School Hours That Meet Your Time Schedule

In accordance with the National Ministry of Education regulations classes can be planned and scheduled on weekends and National Holidays as not to influence student working hours.

Further Education application requirements and procedures:

1. Completion of application form
2. Presentation of documents of previous educational achievement (transcripts)
3. After completion of formal school registration, student identity card will be issued

Future Prospect:

Graduates with a Bachelor in Music Education degree can teach elementary or secondary school general music classes, bands and orchestras as well as provide group instrument lessons. Flexibility offers graduates the opportunity of part time positions as teachers and the remaining time as performers to complete their full time schedule. Bachelor graduates can become licensed to teach band, orchestra, chorus or other basic music classes in public schools. Music therapy is also a bright career choice for graduates
