#### **Naturopathy**

A Bachelor Degree in Naturopathy prepare individuals for the independent professional practice of naturopathic medicine, an holistic therapeutic approach combining medical knowledge with non-invasive natural, homeopathic, and non-Western therapies. Strong emphasis is on disease prevention, wellness, and self-healing. Instruction includes the basic medical sciences, epidemiology, neuroscience, biostatistics, public and community health, laboratory and clinical diagnosis, pharmacology, botanical medicine, homeopathy, principles of Oriental medicine and manipulative therapy. Naturopathic therapeutics, nutrition, case analysis and management are the basis of this alternative approach to patient natural healing and well-being

#### **Entry Qualifications**

1. Senior High School completion or higher
2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.
