Entry Qualifications

2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.

A career in Education Administration upon completion of a Master degree offers an educator the skills and knowledge to go beyond the classroom. Preschool owners can help the owner understand the psychology of learning and classroom management techniques. A guidance counselor helps a young person explore college or vocational choices and decide on a preliminary career. School principals oversee the operation of an elementary school, junior high school or senior high school helping to assist teachers in improving test scores and maintaining discipline. District Administrators are responsible for the well being of the entire school district. District administrators help determine hiring policies as well as set policies on school truancy, testing standards, graduation requirements and the allocation of budgetary funds. Special education teachers work with students who may have a physical, emotional or psychological disability.
