SUMMARY:

Natural medicine, also known as alternative medicine, is typically tied to degree programs focusing on Acupuncture, Chinese medicine or Naturopathy. Students with an interest in natural medicine will likely find the accelerated content of the chosen program beneficial to their understanding of the field. A Master's Degree in Natural Medicine is designed to prepare students to practice acupuncture in combination with natural medicine topics, in clinical sessions where they observe patient consultation, diagnosis and therapy.

1. Bachelor Degree Completion
2. Proof of work experience, used for evaluation and approval by the school authorities for entry qualification.
